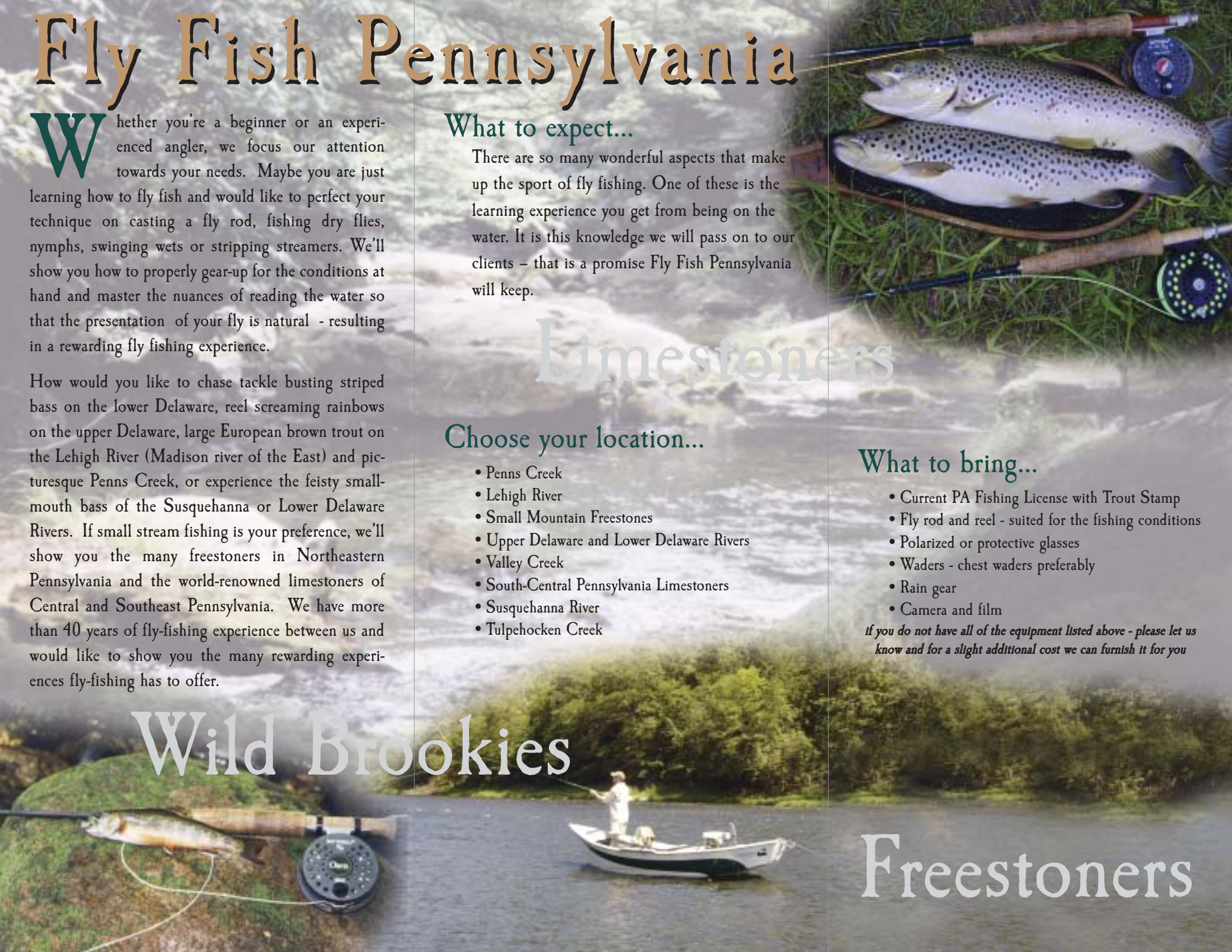
## What to bring...

## Float Trips (One or Two Anglers)

1/2 Day Float (4-5 hours) .....\$200  
Full Day Float (8-9 hours) .....\$300

## Walk-In Freshwater Trips (One or Two Anglers)

1/2 Day Walk-In (4-5 hours) .....\$175  
Full Day Walk-In (8-9 hours) .....\$275

Creek\*, Valley Creek, Lehigh River, Small Mountain  
Freestoners in Eastern PA, Tulpehocken Creek, South-Central

## Walk-In Salt Trips (One or Two Anglers)

1/2 Day Walk-In (4-5 hours) .....\$200  
Saltwater trips will be geared toward the NJ coast. Exact loca-  
tions will be dependent on fishing conditions. Time of day for  
the salt trips will be in the low-light hours of the day - either in  
the morning or the early evening into dusk.

## Reservations...

Please reserve your preferred dates as early as possible. At time  
of reservation a deposit of 50% is required in order to hold your  
date. Deposits are non-refundable or transferable if the outing is  
cancelled less than two weeks in advance. All other cancellations  
will be completely refundable.
